

# Eleaf Pico 25 User Guide

Congrats on purchasing your Eleaf Pico 25 85W! Now let's learn how to use it: The Pico 25 has a 510 thread, therefore it is compatible with most 510 thread atomizers. In this case it is compatible with both our Sai Atomizer and Sequoia Atomizer.

- 1 To turn the Pico 25 on and off simply click the fire button five times. The next few steps will require you to know which coil you're using, and check our coil chart for the proper settings. In this example we will be using the Sai Ceramic Donut coil (just follow these instructions and swap the numbers for the coil you're using).



- 2 Once your Pico is on, click the fire button three (3) times to adjust the mode. Once the fire button is clicked three times the mode it's in will appear on the screen. Simply use the plus and minus buttons on the bottom to select the proper one. In

- 3 When the Pico is in a Temperature Control mode, as it now is, the plus and minus buttons on the bottom will adjust the temperature. So we will click the minus button to lower our temp to 360F.



- 4 For ALL coils you will also need to select the proper wattage. To do this click the fire button 4 times. Once you're on the wattage adjustment screen use the plus and minus buttons on the bottom to select the proper wattage. In this case we will adjust it down to 13W.

- 5 Now all you need to do is enjoy! Just hold the fire button while hitting your rig. And when finished just click the fire button five times to turn the mod off. See our FAQ Pico 25 page for more info.
